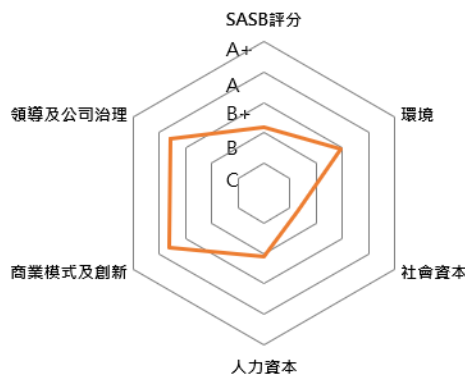
## 投資評價與建議

研究處維持群光中立投資建議：群光 3Q24 獲利低於預期，4Q24 營運動能趨緩，後續關注 AI 於 PC、NB 應用落地，是否進一步帶動購機需求，為潛在上修動能。研究處預估 2024 年/2025 年稅後 EPS 12.31/13.11 元，目前本益比約 2025 年獲利 12 倍，評價未低估，維持中立建議。

群光企業永續評鑑整體為 B+ 等，於 SASB 產業永續議題與跨產業五大永續面向平均得分分別為 B+ 等與 A 等。

## 營運現況與分析

群光成立於 1983 年，主要產品為鍵盤應用(NB、DT、Tablet(外接式)、影像相關產品(NB 及手機相機模組、行車紀錄器、運動攝影機等)、電源供應器(PC、NB、伺服器、LED 照明、印表機、智慧裝置等)，其中，電源供應器(UPS)及 LED 照明產品是由子公司群電負責。群光主要工廠位於中國東莞、重慶、江蘇及泰國。3Q24 營收占比 KB 34%、Image 26%、Power 34%，其他 6%。主要競爭對手為鍵盤(達方、精元等)、影像產品(富士康)、電源供應器(台達電、光寶科、康舒等)。

**3Q24 產品組合壓抑毛利率：**群光 3Q24 單季毛利率 20.4%，低於市場預期的 21%。主要為產品組合中較低毛利率的影像產品出貨較多，單季營收季增 19%，年增 12%，營收比重上升至 26%。另外，匯率同時負面影響毛利率表現，單季營益率 10.8%。業外利益貢獻 4.8 億元，主要為蘇州賣廠利益 7.6 億，匯兌損失約 3 億等等，稅後淨利 24.0 億元，稅後 EPS 3.29 元。低於市場預期的 3.45 元。

**影像產品基期拉高，PC 產品需求略減：**公司預期 4Q24 營收將季減幅度小於 5%，PC 產品需求略減，而影像產品於 3Q24 出貨基期已高，將會有較大季減幅度，但整體營運仍有支撐。群光影像產品中 Action CAM、Surveillance CAM、Video Conference System 等新品於 3Q24 大量出貨，具相當高成長性，三樣新品在影像產品中營收佔比增加，同時減少 Smart Home 於影像產品的比重，以優化產品組合獲利表現。預期群光 4Q24 毛利率些微向上至 20.6%。營益率 10.8%。2024 年受惠商用、高單價鍵盤出貨增加，以及影像新品加入貢獻，預估全年營收 1,019 億元，年增 3.6%，毛利率 20.5%，營益率 10.5%，稅後淨利 89.5 億元，年增 20%，稅後 EPS 12.31 元。

**2025 年 PC 有望商用換機動能：**群光法說會未給出 2025 年量化成長指引，目前來看筆電商用市場具微軟系統換機動能。且群光在高階鍵盤市占率高，成長時力道過往優於市場平均。研究處預期 2025 年筆電市場出貨量年增 4.8%，推估群光鍵盤營收年增 7.2%，影像產品中 Action CAM、Surveillance CAM、Video Conference System 等新品持續帶動營收年增 5%。後續關注 AI 於 PC、NB 應用落地，是否進一步帶動購機需求，為潛在上修動能。研究處預估群光 2025 年營收 1,090 億元，年增 7.1%，毛利率 20.6%，營益率 10.7%，稅後淨 95.4 億元，年增 6.5%，稅後 EPS 13.11 元。

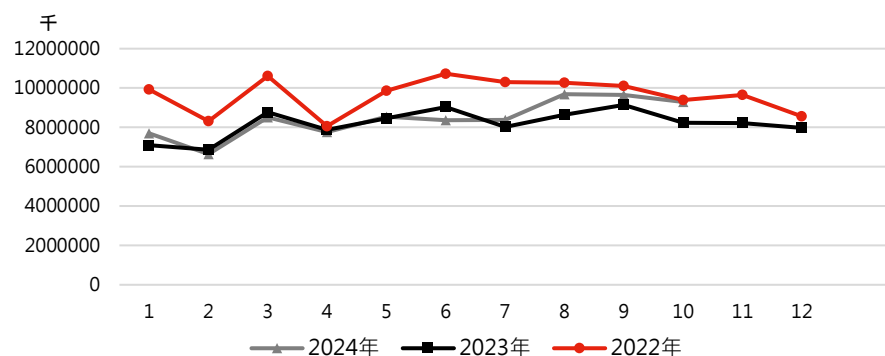

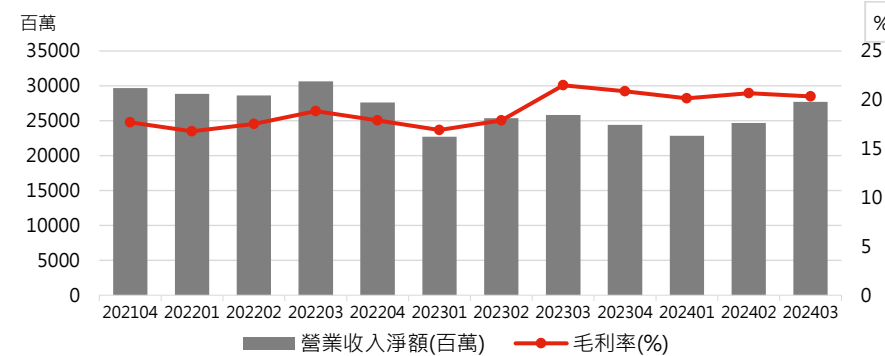

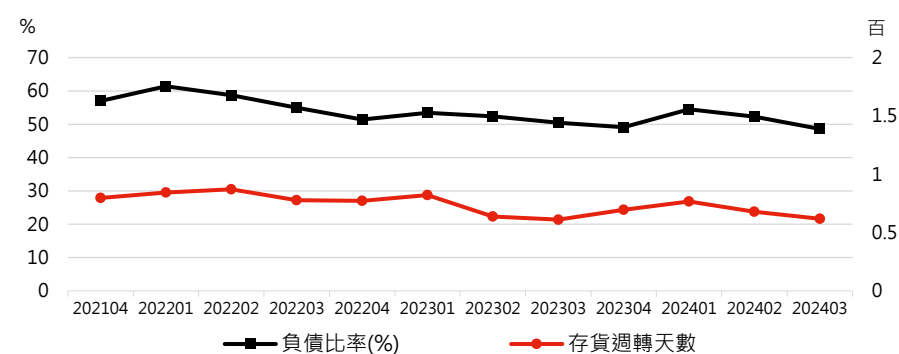
### 近三年單月營收狀況



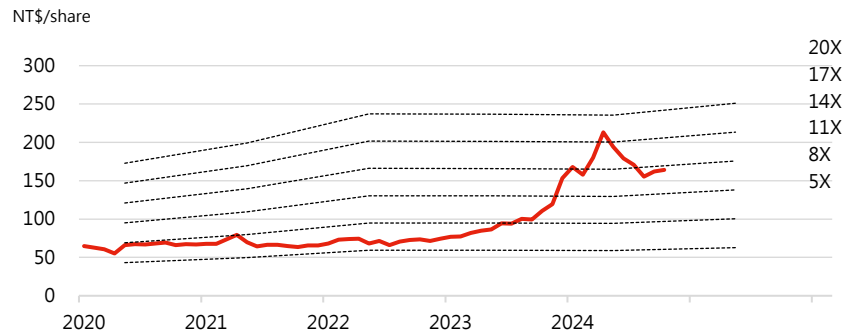
### 近三年單季營收 VS 毛利率趨勢圖



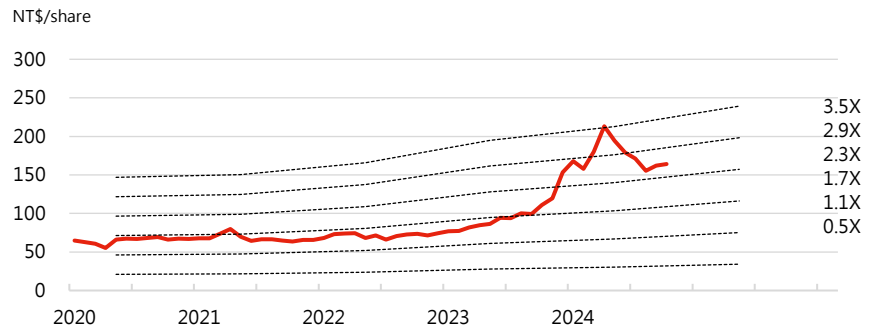
### 負債比率 VS 存貨周轉天數



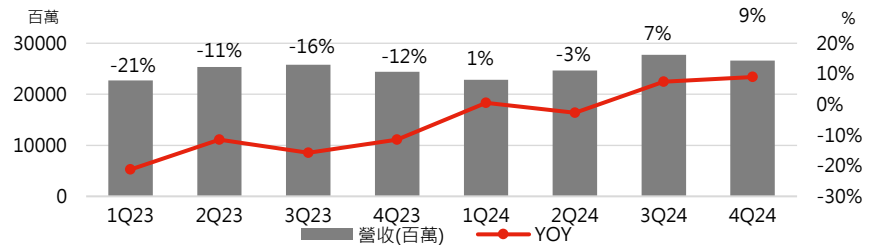
## 歷史 PE 圖



## 歷史 PB 圖

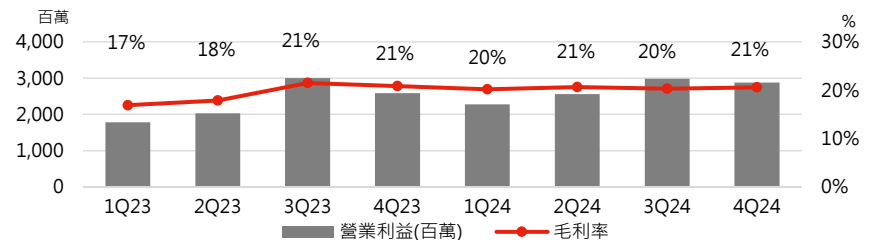


## 近八季營收及 YoY 趨勢圖
